## Spa Update

You may have noticed activity at the pool and spa. We are having our Spa resurfaced. At the same time we had the valves for auto fill installed. The infrastructure to get water to the pool was already there. The only thing we have to add is the bobber system to allow the pool and spa to have water added automatically once the bobber drops below a certain level. This will eliminate the need to use a hose to fill them up. As well as conserve water in case anyone were to forget they were filling the spa and leave the hose for too long.  $\rightleftharpoons$

## **HCD Park Inspection**

We received notice last month that our Park was selected by the Department of Housing and Community Development(HCD) to be inspected this year. We do not have a date for the inspection at this point. The inspector said he expects it will be sometime in March. During this inspection they will inspect the common areas of the park as well as each individual lot. They will be looking for any violations. These violations include but are not limited to, excessive clutter or waste built up in yards, excessive animal feces, exterior paneling or doors that are missing or excessively damaged.

Residents will receive notice from HCD with more information. Seeing as they are doing their inspections, I will tag along with the inspector to get our annual inspections done at the same time. I will place a 24 hour notice on front doors like I did last year the day before your inspection. Feel free to reach out to me with any questions you may have.

## Online Payments

All the growing pains of shifting from one company to another seem to be mostly worked out. That said during the process I had several residents inquire about paying online. There is an option to pay your rent online. This is different from arranging for your payment from your bank, or setting up an automatic withdrawal with me in the office. This is a website you can log onto and pay your monthly rent, once you create your account. When paying with your bank account there is no charge. However if you pay by credit or debit card there is a service fee.
