Speed Limit Changed

The Board can impose fines on those Residents not following the speed limit.

Some are suspected of defecating on their lawns or in their front yards. This activity has been picked up by several different residents' cameras around the neighborhood. Heads up! The City of American Canyon is going to be conducting flip-the-lid audits on waste containers as per State regulations. They will be doing this over the next few months. During the inspections, American Canyon staff will check landfill, recycling and organic bins to see whether customers are placing the correct materials into them. 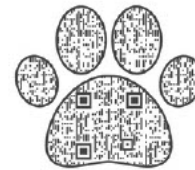
