



Chicago – January 25, 2022 – Total Living Network Celebrates Black History Month 2022

TLN is celebrating Black History Month in 2022 with a line-up of specials throughout February.

UNCHAINED: GENERATIONAL TRAUMA AND HEALING is a one-hour documentary that examines the lingering trauma handed down from the American slavery system. Men and women describe how they broke the emotional chains passed down from their slave ancestors. Others demonstrate the moral courage needed to face their own racial attitudes. In this film, all viewers face the roots of American racism and the processes that usher lasting reconciliation. UNCHAINED will air on Thursday, February 10 @ 8:00pm.

GOSPEL JUBILEE SHOWCASE features everyone from the youngest church performers to the most famous gospel recording artists of the time including: James Cleveland; Grammy Award winner Albertina Walker; the Caravans; Andrae Crouch & The Disciples; the Mighty Clouds of Joy; the Soul Stirrers; the Staple Singers and the Barrett Sisters – all gospel music pioneers. GOSPEL JUBILEE SHOWCASE will air on Thursday, February 17 @ 8:00pm and Saturday, February 19 @ 6:00pm.

THE FATHER I NEVER KNEW takes you on a journey with 5 inner city guys, 4 who grew up in Chicago, and one in St. Louis. They share their stories of growing up without a father, or losing their father at a young age, and what happened to each of them, and then how someone came to their rescue. THE FATHER I NEVER KNEW airs Thursday, February 24 @ 8pm.

The theme for Black History Month 2022 focuses on the importance of BLACK HEALTH AND WELLNESS. This theme acknowledges the legacy of Black scholars, medical practitioners and others.
