Respect and Kindness (Mawadah)

Honesty and Integrity (Sidq)

Sidq is the quality of being truthful and honest in all aspects of life, adhering to the truth as revealed by Allah.

Responsibility and Accountability (Amanah)

Amanah refers to the trust and responsibility entrusted to us by Allah in all aspects of life, including our duties towards Him, ourselves, and others.

Compassion and Empathy (Rahmah)

Rahmah encompasses the mercy, compassion, and empathy that we show to others, reflecting Allah's infinite mercy towards His creation.

Gratitude and Contentment (Shukr)

Shukr is the expression of gratitude and thankfulness to Allah for His countless blessings and being content with His decree.

Perseverance and Patience (Sabr)

Sabr is the ability to remain patient and steadfast in the face of difficulties, trusting in Allah's wisdom and timing.

Justice and Fairness (Adl)

Adl is the principle of fairness, justice, and equity, ensuring that everyone receives their due rights as commanded by Allah.

Humility (Tawadu')

Tawadu' is the quality of being humble, recognizing one's own limitations and the greatness of Allah.
