



Safer Access Doors

We now have a LOCKED BUZZER door at the main building's main entrance and back gym door.

We are still waiting for the install at the Annex.

ALL exterior doors will NOW BE LOCKED - At ALL times

ANY person entering the building will have to be buzzed into the building - no exceptions

SSA able to see and hear the person outside

Only NYPD/FDNY will have passcode/access card to enter

How It Works

- Visitor/staff pushes the button outside the Safe Access Door
- SSA will pick it up and ask the person to identify him/herself.
- Visitors/Staff will be 'buzzed' into the building
- Visitors MUST check in with security and show proof of ID
- Note: Visitor CANNOT be denied entry into the building due to no identification.


Door Alarms

- Are located on exit doors.
- Have clear signage that indicates that the door is alarmed and that the door can only be used in an emergency.
- Remain activated unless there are specific signs posted indicating times of the day when the alarms are temporarily de-activated. Staff must be posted if turned off and be reminded to reactivate the alarm once the activity has ended. Examples of activities include official student entry and dismissal, or recess. <u>Red light means ON.</u>
- Operate on its own battery and key. The alarm has a low battery alert to indicate that a battery should be changed. All alarms operate with a single key. <u>Custodians are responsible for replacing broken alarms and</u> <u>batteries. Principals provide necessary staff, including SSAs, with keys</u> <u>as needed.</u>
- Must be checked regularly, technically by everyone!

EMERGENCY EXIT ONLY STOP ALARM WILL SOUND










