

- **D Determination**: Instilling perseverance and a strong will to achieve goals despite challenges. (self-awareness, self-management)
- **E Excellence**: Encouraging students to strive for their best in all they do, promoting a mindset of continuous improvement. (self-management, responsible decision-making)
- **R Respect**: Teaching students to treat others with kindness, consideration, and honoring differences. (social awareness, relationship skills)
- **S-Safety:** Promoting a safe environment for everyone, emphasizing the importance of physical and emotional well-being. (responsible decision-making, self-management)
