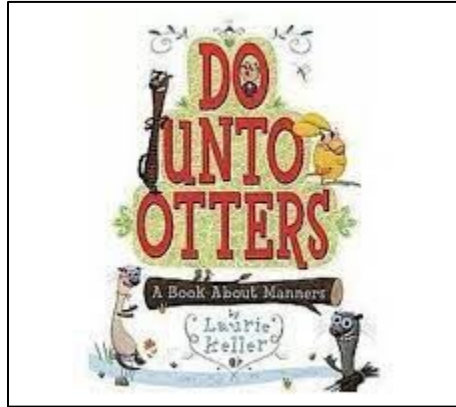

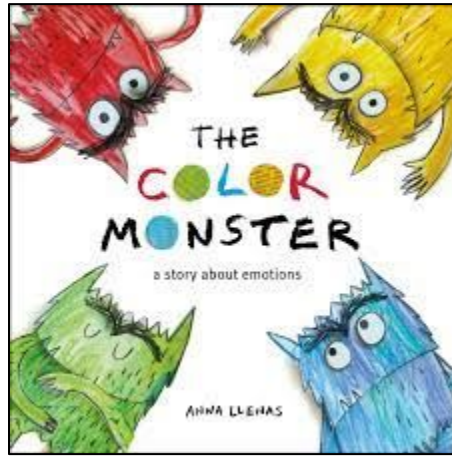

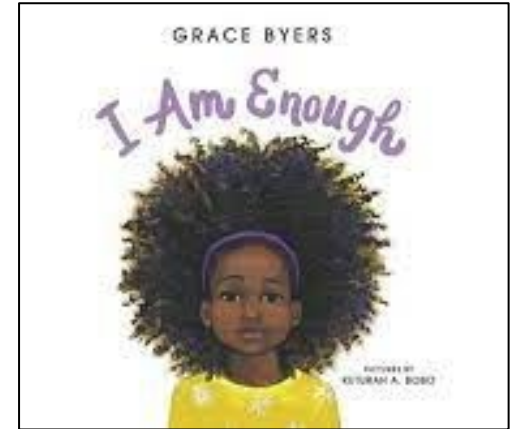
Social Emotional Learning

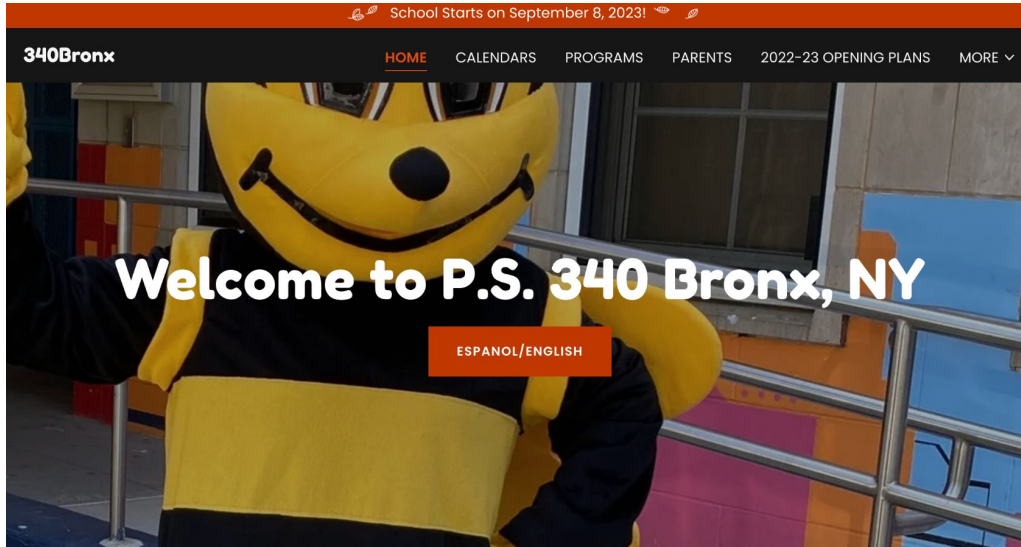
