
Penelope plays with her friends every day.




They ride bikes.




They jump rope.




They play at the park.




But Mommy said Penelope has to play by herself for a while.




At first Penelope felt mad!



Then she felt sad.




Then she got bored.




Really bored.



She went to the kitchen in search of a snack. She found her art supplies, so she drew a picture.




She made drums with pots and pans. Mommy and Daddy were trying to work from home, so that had to stop.



She found a stack of books on the sofa, so she read all of them.




Mommy said Penelope could play in the yard. She found her bubbles under a bush.




She discovered the most fascinating ant. She watched it for a very long time.




Daddy gave Penelope flower seeds to plant.
