

## POINTS TO REVIEW WITH YOUR CHILD:

- a. Make sure your child knows the Names & Sounds of the Letters of the Alphabet. Review them everyday.
- b. Practice Reading the Clock (Telling Time without a digital clock).
- c. Review the Names of Money Coins and their Value.
- d. Read to and with your child everyday (at least 30 minutes a day).
- e. Remind your child that Excellent Attendance and Punctuality are essential for academic success.
- f. Your child should not only know his/her <u>full name</u>, <u>address</u> and <u>telephone #</u> and <u>parent's full name</u> but <u>1</u> emergency contact name and <u>telephone #</u>.
- g. Stress the importance of good manners and respect for others (Please, Thank You, Excuse Me, May I...).
- h. No cell phones, IPOD, toys, nail polish, makeup, color lip gloss or video games in school.
- i. Monitor the Daily Reading Log, the numbers of books completed and the evidence such as book reports or responses.
- j. Monitor all homework and ensure that it is submitted on time so they don't fall behind (Ensure that it has child's name).
