RESOURCES

Raise awareness and accessibility of resources:

We will literally move together through communities in a caravan of vehicles displaying a united, visible front against the violence and drug abuse plaguing our communities— providing resources as well as sparking joy and a sense of value among our residents.

REVERSAL

Provide the reverse of random acts of violence by committing "random" acts of kindness:

We will take to the streets via random drive throughs and popups to amplify the impact of organizations already working on the ground. We want to ensure residents learn first-hand about the numerous practical opportunities to reverse the circumstances and mindsets that feed violence.

REVIVAL

Lift the spirits of those weighed down by violence:

The Community CARE-a-van provides an inspiring visible display of the wide array of organizations that truly care *for* and care *about* those victimized by violence as well as those caught up in perpetrating violence. We aim to inspire and equip residents to pursue a healthy non-violent future, restoring hope in those who feel no one cares or that there is no way out.

The CARE-a-van will continue to pop up throughout the year. It is a movement to extend the visibility of the availability and accessibility of critical anti-violence resources.
