Mary T. Cickavage, 92, a guest at Broad Mountain Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, died peacefully Wednesday evening at the center.

Born in Mahanoy Plane she was a daughter of the late William and Mary “Dubosky” Boner. She had been employed as a telephone operator for the former Bell Telephone Company until her retirement in 1960.
