Dennis T. "Denny" Lenahan, 53, of Indian Mountain Lakes, Albrightsville, died Monday, Oct. 14, in his residence. He was the husband of Diane "Morgan" (Gilberstadt) Lenahan. They celebrated their third wedding anniversary Feb. 19.

Born in Ashland, on May 24, 1949, he was the son of the late John T. and Virginia (Cooper) Lenahan.

He graduated from North Schuylkill High School in 1967 and Penn State University.

A veteran of the U.S. Army, he attained the rank of sergeant while serving two tours of duty during the Vietnam Era, with the 199th Light Infantry Division. He received the special Vietnam Metal of Gallantry. He was a life member of the Disabled American Veterans Association.

He was a training supervisor in the specialty gases division of Air Products and Chemicals in Trexlertown.

A member of St. Peter the Fisherman Catholic Church, Lake Harmony, he was a former member and Eucharist minister at St. Elizabeth of Hungary Catholic Church, Whitehall.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, Joseph Patrick Lenahan and John Matthew Lenahan, both of Girardville; one sister, Eileen A. Ward of Pottsville; two brothers, John M. Lenahan of Tullahoma, Tenn., and Gregory J. Lenahan of Wyoming; one stepdaughter, Amy Marie Frank of Orange Park, Fla.; two step grandsons; one niece; two nephews; and first wife, Diane (Durose) Lenahan of Girardville.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday, Oct. 19, at St. Elizabeth of Hungary Catholic Church, Fullertown Ave. and Pershing Blvd., Whitehall. Interment will be in St. Joseph's Cemetery, Frackville.

A calling hour will take place one hour prior to the mass on Saturday, at the church.
