May 5, 1927 - May 2, 2023

Elizabeth T. "Betty" Luciani, lifelong resident of Frackville, passed away peacefully at her home on Tuesday surrounded by her loving family just 3 days short of her 96th birthday.

Born at 119 E. Spring Street in Frackville, she was a daughter of the late Martin and Margaret Dougherty Condrón. She worked as a telephone operator for Bell Telephone of Pennsylvania and in the domestics department for Boscov's until her retirement.

Betty attended St. Joseph's Elementary School and graduated from Frackville High School in 1946. She was a member of St. Joseph the Worker Parish, Frackville and the Knights of Columbus Auxiliary Council 2580 where she held the office of president from 1974 to 1977.

On February 5, 1955, she married Leo R. Luciani Sr. who passed away on January 24, 1988. In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by her siblings: William Condrón, Nancy Condrón, Mary Condrón, Helen Condrón Fidler and Helen Pascowskie Wolfe.

Betty was affectionately known to her family as "mom mom" and is survived by her two children: Leo R. Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Monday, May 8th at 11 a.m. at St. Joseph the Worker Parish (St. Ann's Church) with Rev. Giuseppe Esposito, pastor, as the celebrant. Friends are invited to her viewing at the church on Sunday, May 7th from 5 to 8 p.m. and again on Monday morning from 9:30 a.m. until the time of mass.
