Peter "Pete" Prock, 89, of 731 W. Pine St., Englewood, Frackville, died shortly after arrival Tuesday at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center.

Born in Frackville, he was a son of the late Michael and Mary Myhalic Prock.

He had been employed as a truck driver/mechanic at the former Frackville Block Plant and was then employed as a truck driver for the former N&J Trucking Company, Frackville, until his retirement in 1970.

He was an Army veteran of World War II, having served in both Africa and India.

He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church, Frackville, and was a life member of Friendship Fire Company, Englewood.
