## Special Happenings

- On Monday, January 15, 2024, there will be no school due to Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
- On Friday, January 26, 2024, Small Wonders will be closing at 4:30PM. Please see "Important Update" section below for more information.
- On Wednesday, February 14, 2024, Small Wonders will celebrate Valentine's Day. Children will exchange Valentine's Day cards and have a special snack (provided by Small Wonders, the menu will be posted.) The Audubon Society will be visiting Small Wonders to do a pre-school aged nature program, "Owl Babies." If your child would like to add this day, it will be \$40.00 for the ½ day.
- During the month of February teachers will be sending home a mid-year evaluation
  of your child's progress at Small Wonders Nursery & Daycare, Inc. At this time,
  letters will be sent home if there are any concerns with speech, vision, hearing, or
  learning development issues, so that referrals can be made to the appropriate
  agencies to further help with your child's development. In accordance with
  Massachusetts General Law, all evaluations <u>must be signed and returned</u> to
  Small Wonders and will be kept in your child's file. You may keep a copy for your
  records, but we do need the <u>entire evaluation</u> back and not just the front page.
- We are talking about hibernation! There is a "bear cave" in the music room. It is located on the stage, please do not let your child go up there without their teacher.



Please have your child bring in a teddy bear to sleep in our bear cave for the winter (during hibernation). All bears will be returned in the spring (after hibernation). Letters were sent home on January 3<sup>rd</sup>. We will celebrate spring with our bears by having a Teddy Bear Picnic once all off our bears wake up on March 19, 2024.

- On Monday, February 19, 2024, there will be no school due to Presidents' Day.
- During the week of February 19<sup>th</sup>, our hours will temporarily change to 8AM 4:30PM (Tues Friday) due to low enrollment this week. Please plan accordingly, thank you. Please let us know if your child is attending this week.
