Take Flight: A Comprehensive Intervention for Students with Dyslexia Therapist Training Introductory Course

Take Flight: A Comprehensive Intervention for Students with Dyslexia is a two-year curriculum written by the staff of the Luke Waites Center for Dyslexia and Learning Disorders. The program contains the five components of effective reading instruction as identified by the National Reading Panel.

Brief description of the two year process to becoming a Certified Academic Language Therapist (CALT)

Certification Process: The therapist-in-training must complete 2 years of instructional hours (200), pass 10 demonstration videos, and complete 700 hours of therapy using the Take Flight program. Therapists are then eligible to complete the alliance exam through the Academic Language Therapist Association.

Year 1 Introductory Course: 2 weeks (10 days) of classwork and four, 1 day seminars (2 in the fall and 2 in the spring), in addition to 5 passing demonstration videos and attendance of one professional conference (10 continuing education hours are required.

Year 2 Advance Course: The same requirements as year 1, but with the advanced coursework and materials.
