THEORY OF ABNER QUINN FAMILY

My theory is, Abner Quinn was the son of Loftin and Mary Canady Quinn of Carteret County, N.C., and brother to Loftin, George, Caleb, Thomas, Enoch, David, James (all of who migrated to Duplin County, N.C.), and Margaret and William Quinn.

The source of my theory is as follows:

Loflin Quinn was granted "320 acres of land on November 9, 1764 in Carteret County on the north side of Bogue sound, joining the mouth of Jumping Run, David Shephard, Col. Lovick, and the sound." (Source: Grant # 177 Carteret County, Book 18 Page 103)

Loflin Quinn "petition to Gov. William Tryon that more land be granted him due to surveyor's mistake. Loflin states he is very poor, has a wife, and nine children to support." This document has no date when petition. On the back it's "dated Oct. 14, 1767 ordered a new entry for the surplus land ("laying"-lined out) vacant on his own grant; granted and order for resurvey of the vacant land."

At the time of this petition, it is my theory that a tenth child, Loftin Quinn, being the oldest had already gone out on his own.

Loflin's will, dated February 17, 1766 only names his wife, Mary, sons William, Thomas, and daughter, Margaret. It's my theory that these are minor children; and all others have migrated to Duplin County, N.C.

My theory is that Loflin, Loftin, and Laughlin Quinn of Carteret County, N.C. are the same person. Carteret County Court Minutes dated March 1772 state that Laughlin Quinn had "arrived to the age of 60 and had inhabited in that county for 30 odd years. Was unable to support himself and family and pay taxes." This would put Loflin's, or Laughlin's, birth year about 1712. Loflin died in 1774. (Source: Will and Probate records of Carteret Co., N.C.)

After Loflin's death, a Deed of Sale dated September 7, 1778 from Mary Quinn and Thomas Quinn sold 100 acres in Carteret County, N.C. It is my theory that after the land sale, Mary and son, Thomas, migrated to Duplin County where other family members now lived.

After arriving in Duplin County, Mary was granted 100 acres of land by patent # 1332, December 31, 1792. (Source: Duplin Co. Deed Book G, page 299)

Mary died between December 31, 1792 and February 16, 1793. On May 5, 1797 the heirs of Mary Quinn; Thomas Quinn, Abner Quinn, Caleb Quinn, David Quinn, James Quinn, George Quinn and Enoch Quinn all of Duplin County, N.C. except Abner Quinn is of Carteret County, N.C., sold to Loftis Quinn the 100 acres that was granted to Mary. Margaret and William Quinn are not mentioned in this transaction and is believed deceased. (Source: Duplin Co. Probate Records and Deed Book P, Page 282)

Abner resided in Duplin County for awhile and was granted one hundred acres of land by patent dated July 1, 1779. On September 4, 1783, Abner, now of Carteret County sold same to William Nethercutt. (Source: Duplin Co. Deed Book 1-A, page 139)

Abner Quinn is the only Quinn listed in the 1790 U.S. Census in Carteret County, N.C. His household listed 1 male 16 and up, and 3 under 16, and 3 females.

Abner was born about 1755 (Arrived at birth year by estimation of age in 1800, 1810, and 1820 Carteret Co. census) Died between years 1820 and 1830. His wife's name and date of marriage is unknown. She died between the years of 1840 and 1850, between age of 70 and 80 years. They resided in the district of Newport River, north side in Carteret County, N.C.

On March 26, 1800 Abner entered and claimed one hundred and fifty acres of land in the county lying on the north side of Newport River on the east side of Deep Creek, joining his own land he now lives on near Edward Canaday's land.

The number of children born to this family is not known. The 1800 census listed 5 male children and 2 female children. The 1810 census listed him, Abner, Sr., head of household with 6 male children and 2 female children. Another family has been added to this 1810 census. Abner, Jr. was the head of another household listing 3 male children and 1 female child.

I think Abner, Jr. was the oldest male child of Abner's household in the 1800 census, his age was listed 16 to 26 and would be about 18, estimating his birth year about 1782. I believe the other two sons may be David and Loftin Quinn and the two girls may be Jenny Quinn and Welthy Quinn. David married Abigail Bell, January 1, 1811 in Carteret County. Loftin married Mary "Polly" Gould, September 25, 1814. Loftin and Polly moved to Shelby Co., AL. A Jabez W. Quinn was bondsman for Loftin's marriage. I think Jabez W. Quinn could be another of Abner's sons. Jenny Quinn married John Bell, bond date December 29, 1803 and Welthy married John Mann, bond date January 3, 1826. (Source: Carteret County marriage records and the files of Mary Southerland)

Abner Quinn, Jr. (became Abner Quinn, Senior after the birth of a son name Abner in 1815) was born c 1782. Died on or about the 3rd day of November 1851 in Carteret County, N.C. (Source: Carteret Co. Estate Records, Feb. Term 1852). Abner married Ruth Gould on August 18, 1807 in Carteret County, N.C. Daughter of Michael Saunders Gould and Elizabeth "Betsy" Post Gould. Ruth died between the years of 1852 and 1860. They resided in the Bogue Sound District of Carteret County, N.C.

The 1850 census listed 2 males in Abner and Ruth's household, David M. age 14 and Edmond age 8. Relationship is not given. Ruth is 64 years old at this time and it's believe David and Edmond are their grandsons.

Abner Quinn, Junior, son of Abner Quinn, Sr. and Ruth Gould Quinn, was born August __, 1815 in Carteret County, N.C. Died September 30, 1901 in Wilmington, New Hanover Co., N.C. Buried in Bellevue Cemetery, Section I, Lot 9, Wilmington, N.C. Abner was married four times.

After the 1850 Carteret County census was taken, Abner moved his family to Wilmington, New Hanover County, NC. The 1860 New Hanover County census listed Abner age 45, occupation as wheelwright. Elizabeth age 43, David age 22, Jas. (not sure if this is short for James or Jabez) age 21, Edmond age 16, and Nancy age 14. It's believed Harriette is deceased since she is not listed in the household. She would have been about age 12.

Fourth, Abner Quinn, Jr. married Elizabeth Blaney age 45 on December 31, 1874 in Wilmington, New Hanover County, N.C. Daughter of Lewis and Nancy Hines. Elizabeth was born February __, 1831 in Duplin County, N.C. Died October 2, 1904 in New Hanover Co., NC. Buried in Bellevue Cemetery, Section I, Lot 9, Wilmington, N.C. (Source: New Hanover County marriage register and Bellevue Cemetery Records)

(The 1900 New Hanover Co. census listed in Abner and Elizabeth's household, a daughter, Mary B. Barnes age 47, born April 1853, married 22 years, widow, had 6 children, only 1 living at time. Listed a grandson age 16, born February __, 1884. It's believed that the daughter and grandson are Elizabeth's from a previous marriage.)
