Remains brought home and interred in family burying ground, on the 6th inst. He leave a wife, three children, also three brothers who have faithfully served their country. His prect. has furnished 98 volunteers, no conscripts nor has any man hired a substitute. Fourteen have offered up their lives upon the altar of liberty.
