

NEWSPAPERS

Newspaper Resources Wilmington and Duplin County

Through the course of my research there is little substitute for locating an article relating to a relative. With more than 2000 newspapers having published within the state of North Carolina, there are a great many references to old articles in almost every family's genealogy books. I became quite tired of looking for references that were simply nothing more than ghosts entries where the name of the newspaper did not exist.

Here you will find enough information about the actual name of the publications to get you started with your research.

Since 1959 the NC Archives and History section of the Library of North Carolina have done a most excellent job at microfilming as much information as they could. Next time you are in Raleigh, a warm thank you should be the first thing you do.

In 1751 the state's first officially recognized newspaper was the North Carolina Gazette in New Bern, Craven County, North Carolina. Since then there have been many.

Between January of 1991 and March of 1999 the North Carolina Division of Archives and History along with the State Library of North

Carolina took part in a grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities coordinated by the Library of

Congress to establish the United States Newspaper Program of which the North Carolina Newspaper Project was formed.

At the end of the project in 1999 the project staff had committed more than 3 million articles to microfilm.


Those newspapers not microfilmed and catalogued during that time are not included in these listings.

Most newspapers started after 1970 are also not included in some cases.

There are a great many archives that have been made by commercial organizations, but I find their work to be a bit organized and not well planned out.

Of course, feel free to take what is here and use it in anyway you see fit. The information after all is a part of the history of the state of North Carolina and should always be available.

This section of the Book of Clues is provided as an addition to the standard material to assist the researcher in finding the resource more quickly. Although this information is online, the manner in which it is presented is more than cumbersome when researching a particular date range.

Duplin County Newspapers 1872-1879

1872-1876 | The Magnolia Monitor Magnolia, North Carolina

Began a short few months in 1872 after the appearance of the Weekly Record - The Magnolia Advertiser its earliest published issue was from March 19, 1873 to October 11, 1876. OCLC #10438894.

1872 | Weekly Record - The Magnolia Advertiser Magnolia, North Carolina

The earliest known issue was printed for May 17, 1872 with its final issue being published on November 8, 1872 and would become the Duplin Record Magnolia Edition. OCLC #24611104

1874-1877 | The Weekly Record Magnolia, North Carolina

In 1874 the earliest known issue is from April 13, 1876 where the last available issue is from May 10, 1877. This newspaper continued as a part of the Duplin Record in Magnolia.

1874-1875 | Progress Sentinel Kenansville, North Carolina

Ceased to exist as a company in 1963 with no known published material or an OCLC number. The principal partners merged their corporate name with the Duplin Times in Kenansville to form the Duplin Times Progress Sentinel.

1874-1875 | The Duplin Record Magnolia, Warsaw & Kenansville, North Carolina

Magnolia, NC - The earliest known issue was on October 30, 1874 with its last known issue of January 15, 1875. This paper was a continuation


in effort of the Weekly Record - The Magnolia AdverPser. OCLC #24610997.

1877-1879 | North Carolina Amateur Rose Hill, North Carolina

Began in 1877 its only known issue is from September 1, 1879. OCLC #24773134.

1879-1880 | The Warsaw Brief MenHon Warsaw, North Carolina

Began in 1879 the only known issue is from September 1, 1880. The paper officially went out of business in 1882. OCLC #11922092.



Duplin County Newspapers 1900-1921

1900-1902 | The Duplin Journal Kenansville, North Carolina

The Duplin Journal began in 1900 with the earliest known issue being published on July 19, 1901 with its last issue being published on November 20, 1902.

The Duplin Record in Warsaw merged with the Duplin Record in Kenansville to form the Duplin Herald. OCLC #24222937.

1905 - Present | Duplin Times Progress SenHnel Kenansville, North Carolina

The Duplin Times Progress SenPnel began on October 3, 1963 after the merger of The Duplin Times and the Progress SenPnel which also absorbed the Pink Hill Review. The Newspaper is currently still being published. OCLC #13181993.

1905-1911 | Eastern Carolina News Kenansville, North Carolina

The Eastern Carolina news began around 1905 with its earliest known issue being published on May 20, 1908 and its last known issue being published on December 28, 1911. OCLC #24512956.

1911-1914 | Duplin Enterprise Rose Hill & Warsaw, North Carolina


Began in Warsaw in 1911 with the earliest known issue being published for Independence Day, July 4, 1912. This paper was then moved from Rose Hill and Published in Warsaw from April 30, 1914. OCLC #34871948.

1915-1922 | Duplin Record Warsaw, North Carolina

Began in Warsaw about 1915 its earliest known issue is from March 3, 1921 and its last known issue from December 21, 1922. The paper was formed by the merger of the Duplin Record in Warsaw and the Duplin Journal and became the Duplin Herald. OCLC #39232073.

1921 | Duplin-Pender Enterprise Rose Hill & Warsaw, North Carolina

Published in Warsaw, this paper appeared only once on October 7, 1921. After the company that printed The Enterprise was destroyed by fire, this abbreviated issue of the newspaper was likely printed as a substitute and is likely the issue printed for that purpose by the Duplin Enterprise. Duplin County Newspapers 1922-Present

1922 | County Audit Faison, North Carolina

The County Audit began in Faison in 1922 with the earliest known issue being published on November 1, 1922 with its last issue being published on December 1, 1922. OCLC #39196976.

1923-1992 | Wallace Enterprise Wallace, North Carolina

Began in 1923 the earliest known issue is from August 16, 1931 unPI its last know of issue of December 31, 1992. OCLC #13285969.

1933-1938 | The Duplin Herald Warsaw, North Carolina

Began in 1933 with its earliest known issue being published on January 3, 1935 and its last known issue being published on January 6, 1938. OCLC #31906241.

1933-1963 | The Duplin Times Warsaw & Kenansville, North Carolina

The Duplin Times in Kenansville began in 1933 with the earliest known issue being published on January 3, 1935 with its last issue being published on September 26, 1963 when the paper ceased to operate as a result of a merger with the Progress SenPnel to form a new brand in the Duplin Times Progress SenPnel. OCLC #26889703.

1941-1943 | Junior Times Warsaw, North Carolina

Began in 1941 the earliest known issue is from July 28, 1941 with the final known issue being from November 30, 1943. OCLC #38052372

1946-1950 | The Duplin CiHzen Warsaw, Faison & Pink Hill

Began in 1946 its earliest known issue dates from August 25, 1949 with its last known issue to be from January 26, 1950. This publication was continued by the Warsaw-Faison News and the Duplin Enterprise in Rose Hill. OCLC #30682255.

1950-1992 | The Warsaw-Faison News Warsaw, North Carolina

Began in 1950 perhaps, the earliest known issue is from February 1, 1951 and the last known issue being published issue reaching the audience on Christmas Eve 1992. The final printed copy is from December 24, 1992. OCLC #13291921
