MATERIALS

All students need to bring in a 3 pronged Choir Folder that will stay in the choir room and be used daily. If lost or destroyed, the student is required to replace it promptly. Students need to keep a pencil in their choir folder at all times. Material checks will be conducted throughout the school year.

EXPECTATIONS

Students will attend all performances.

Students will wear appropriate concert attire.

GRADING PROCEDURES
