

## LERAE KESSEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

LeRae Kessel, a former CCT president, died in July of 1982 while still a young woman. A scholarship fund was established immediately after her death. Mrs. Kessel was a tireless worker for the community and for the Theatre. She especially favored projects that benefited children and young people.

The value of the scholarship depends not he amount of money the fund raises from investments and contributions each year. Normally, it is about \$500. Application requirements are:

- 1. Must be a student graduating from an accredited high school in Carteret County.
- 2. Must have an overall grade average of not less than B. This requirement may be modified if there are other indications of good scholarship such as a good SAT score.
- 3. Must state his/her plan for study in the fields of the dramatic arts or technical theatre.
- 4. Must submit a typewritten resume which includes experience relative to the selected field of study, a statement of goals, and how this scholarship might help meet those goals.
- 5. Must submit
- 6. Should submit two (2) letters of recommendation: one from a teacher or instructor in the particular field and, one from an adult (family, friend, minister, employer, etc.) concerning applicant's character.
