

COVID-19 UPDATE

The rapidly unfolding circumstances surrounding the Coronavirus pandemic have required all of us to make decisions and then revise them with a great deal of speed. On March 20, 2020 we held our graduation ceremony for the Jan. 6, 2020 Evening Nursing Assistant Training Program (NATP) and our students were scheduled to take their State Exam on April 1, 2020. We received notice that the State was postponing the exam until further notice. The State however is allowing those graduates to work as Nurse Aides at skill nursing facilities during the interim. We will notify the impacted student population when the State exam will be available.

The April 6, 2020, the Day Nursing Assistant Training Program began but due to the shelter in place City of Los Angeles requirement combined with the non-essential worker restrictions placed on our skilled nursing facility partners, required us to suspend and postpone classes until a later date. We anticipate that program to restart in June.

We anticipate and plan to begin all classes again during the month of June either through distance learning (online) or direct classroom for the theory portion of the training and hands-on lab training for the skill's portion. Schedules are expected to be published by June 1, 2020. Registration for the summer classes will begin May 15th. During this interim period, we have been quite busy. H&R Healthcare School has received approval from the Bureau for Postsecondary Education (BPPE). Approval to operate by BPPE means H&R Healthcare School is in compliance with state standards as set forth in the CEC and 5, CCR.

We have also added some new programs to our offerings. A Home Health Aide Training Program (HHA) and Restorative Nursing Aide (RNA) programs for CNAs are now available. Lastly, to accommodate the distance learning requirements, we are preparing our online student learning system to facilitate an exciting and informative learning experience.
