The Jaxon Klempel Memorial scholarship is designed for local individuals who want to continue their education past High School. All are eligible to apply, there will be a preference for those attending a Trade or Vocational school however.

It is created in honor of Jaxon T. Klempel who loved being able to work with his hands while out on the ranch or in school. It is to honor Jaxon's legacy of volunteering his time to different community organizations and always willing to lend a hand to those around him.

Who's eligible?

To be eligible for this award, applicants should have a commitment and passion for gaining the knowledge and skills related to agriculture or the trade industries, just as Jaxon Klempel did. Applicant must have participated in extra curricular activities offered by Harding County High School, or have volunteered time with a civic organization around the tri-county area, Harding, Perkins or Butte counties.

Furthermore, eligible applicants are only those people who are current residents of the South Dakota counties of Harding, Butte, or Perkins and attending Harding County High School.

How to Apply

When applying, fill out the scholarship application completely and submit it before the deadline on April 15th.

During the application process you will be asked to write an essay (500 words) in which you will be answering the following question: ***What do you want to be remembered as? Or What can you do to have a positive impact on your community?***
