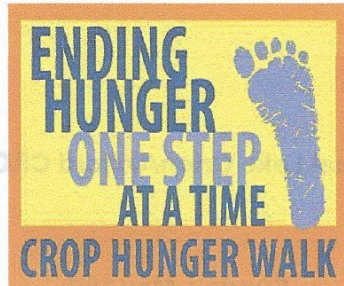


43rd Annual Lake Orion/Oxford CROP WALK



It is time for the 43rd Annual Lake Orion/Oxford CROP Walk. For those of you that do not know, the Walk is a fundraiser for Church World Services. CWS, an interdenominational faith-based organization transforming communities around the globe through just and sustainable responses to hunger, poverty, displacement and disaster. Just a few of the things they supply are food to impoverished countries; chickens for families in Kenya; pigs for families in Tanzania; household latrines for families in Cambodia; rainwater harvesting systems; just to name a few. 25% of all money raised stays in our community, it goes to LOVE INC and FISH (food pantry) in Lake Orion/Oxford.

At the information meeting for the annual CROP WALK, our representative from Paint Creek UMC, Gail Stoner, found out that we had won the "Wooden Shoe" award. Our church won the "Wooden Shoe" award for outstanding walker participation in 2022 and 2024. In 2023, Paint Creek, one of the twelve participating churches won the Golden Shoe award, which is for the 10 year best funds that the church has raised.
