

In Memoriam: Midge Gosling (1941 – 2013)

A memorial service will be held at the Cathedral of the Pines in Rindge on Saturday 15 June 2013 at 11:00 a.m. for Advent member Marjorie C. "Midge" Gosling. Pastor Bob Lindberg will be officiating. Midge passed away 5 January 2013 at the Catholic Medical Center in Manchester following a brief illness. She was 71.

Midge was born November 20, 1941 in Mineola, New York, the daughter of the late David A. and Jean (Van Vranken) Comstock of Wilton, Connecticut. She moved to Rindge in 1986 with her husband, Joseph A. "Tony" Gosling, D.D.S., who passed away in March 2010.

She was active in the Rindge Historical Society and the Rindge Woman's Club, where she served as president from 1990 to 1992. Midge was also a generous supporter of the Monadnock Community Hospital and the Cathedral of the Pines.

She is survived by her cousin Richard H. Comstock Jr. of Chappaqua, New York; his children, Richard H. Comstock III and Meredith C.
