



In-Person Class Procedures

We appreciate everyone's patience and cooperation with our new procedures to help keep our dancers and staff safe and healthy.

1. Entering/Exiting the studio:

Dancers will only be able to enter the building at their scheduled class time. We will have someone at the door to let the dancers in and out of the building after classes are over.



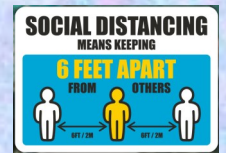
2. Masks:

All dancers/staff/family members will be required to wear masks when entering and exiting the building, along with while they are in between classes or waiting for the start of class. Once movement has begun dancers may take their masks down while dancing and maintaining a 6ft distance. If a dancer or family member has a medical condition please state that when entering.



3. Social Distancing:

6ft boxes will be taped on the floor to help dancers maintain social distancing in class.



4. Cleaning/Sanitization:

Teachers and staff have cleaning procedures to follow in between each class. Hand Sanitizer will be available in each room along with entering the building. Please make sure dancers have their own sanitizer in their dance bags for their own use through out their time in the studio.



5. Waiting rooms/Front desk:

The waiting room will be closed to parents. Our front desk will be open but we do ask that appointments are made to cut down on the amount of traffic in the waiting room. Please call or email with questions or concerns first.



6. When to stay home:

If your dancer or a member in your household has a fever, shortness of breath or not feeling well, please call immediately and let us know that they will be staying home.





In-Person Class Procedures



◆ Can a Parent walk a dancer into the building?

A Parent may walk a dancer into the studio ONLY if they have no COVID symptoms and their dancer may be upset or anxious with a mask on. Once the dancer is calmed the parent will need to exit the building.

◆ Where do Parent's wait while their dancer is in class?

We ask that all parents and siblings wait outside or in their cars while their dancer is in class. If we have any issues we will come out and get you.

◆ Can a Dancer use the restroom?

We ask that all dancers use the restroom at home before entering the studio. If a dancer does need to use the restroom while in the studio they can and will be cleaned afterwards. Parents and siblings will not be permitted to use the restrooms in the studio at this time.

◆ Will the Barres, Mats and props be used?

We will be using the barres and mats when needed during classes. They will be cleaned after each class. Props will have limited use and also cleaned after each class.

◆ Are dancers allowed to bring their bags & water bottles into class?

Dancer's will have designated areas to place ONLY their dance bags and water bottles. We ask that dancers provide their own water for their entire time at the studio. We also ask that dancers only bring their dance bags into the studio space. The cubby's in the waiting room will be off limits.
