

Participation Rules

For the benefit of all players, spectators, and customers of the hosting location, it is a requirement that all players exhibit proper sportsmanship and behavior at all times. This applies to all tournaments and league play. This applies to your teammates as well as the opposing team. Your participation in the program may be revoked with no refund of fees paid.

All matches must be played. Make-up weeks will be scheduled and holiday weeks will be considered as make-up opportunities also. Matches may be pre-played and post-played. All matches must be completed within one week of the last regularly scheduled week of play. Any team that does not complete all of their matches will forfeit any prize money earned.

End of league celebrations will be offered by division and on the normal night of play after all matches are completed. The location of the first place team will be given the first opportunity to host the party. Players must be present to receive their prize money.

No player is allowed to accept or solicit gratuities from any location. This includes, but is not limited to, payment of entry fees, match fees.

Player substitutions must be called into the league office at least 6 hours prior to the start of the match. All substitutions must be equal in rank or rate to, or lower than, the originally rostered player.

For the functionality of the Darts Live dart boards, any player that is in a division using the Darts Live boards must have his/her registered Darts Live card with him/her at the time of the match. Only the registered card number will work with the software.

Be prepared to throw when it's your turn; do not delay the match for any reason. No lunging or crossing of the throw line is allowed. Both team captains are to be responsible for monitoring this during the match. The first offense should be given a warning; the second and every offense thereafter will be considered a foul and the score of the offending dart will be manually removed using the software of the dart board being used.

If the division is operated on the Arachnid Galaxy 3. The match may be played remotely, provided that both captains agree and an appropriate board is available in both locations. As well, cell and/or bar phone communication must be readily available to both teams. Sportsmanship is expected for all video and or text play & communication. Both home and away matches must be played remotely if this option is being used.

When looking at formats, players should always be highest to lowest rating when considering who will be players 1 thru 4. Home team should go first for the first game. Thereafter the losing team goes first throughout the match.
