Board Meeting Agenda

I. Call to Order - Eddie

- Opening Remarks – Eddie called the meeting to order at 6:16 p.m. His goal is to try and make the club happy and exciting. He asked how we were doing. Penny Weimer remarked that there is trouble with the logos. Also there has been some blow back on the SOPs and Bylaws.
- Approval of March 11th, 2026, Board Meeting Minutes - Penny Weimer made a motion to approve the minutes with 2 corrections. Chris Cowgill seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

II. Club Finances – Cindy

- Financial Review/Questions – Cindy Berta noted that the club email needs to be changed from going to Susan Crolla to her. She reviewed the financial statement – January 1 – May 11, 2026. Membership Dues is currently reported as net of PayPal fees. Ongoing the fees will be reported as an expense. YTD there is a net loss of \$1,608.35. There is money in savings to offset the loss if needed. She also reported that money has not been paid to the February charity – Hands & Hearts for Horses as an activity report has not been

submitted. Mary Grant will follow up on getting the report. There is also an issue with Go Daddy that needs to be looked into. Cindy was also not aware that a quarterly payment of \$300 is submitted to Florida Cares. There was an issue that the mail was being returned to senders as our PO Box was vacant since no payment had been made. Leanne Rhodes solved the issue by going to the post office and paying \$138 for 6 months.

III. Membership - Mary

- Membership overview -Mary – Mary Grant reported that there are currently 149 members. There were 2 new members that joined May 1st.

- Refresh & Update of SOP & By Laws (**SOP Vote/ Set By-Laws Vote**) – Eddie, Mary, Bob, Gregg. The Bylaws and SOP was reviewed by the board. Bob Wattendorf will update with proposed changes.

- Business Cards – Penny passed around club business cards members of the board could order. A sheet was passed around so each board member could indicate what information they would like on their cards.
