Nutcracker Performance to benefit The Brighton Center

Our annual Christmas Performance benefiting the Brighton Center will take place on Friday, DECEMBER 9th at St. Henry High School at 7:00 pm. Please read the following details regarding our Nutcracker performance and let me know if you have any questions.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures

For the safety of all our dancers, every dancer will need to be signed in and out before and after the show. Upon arrival at the theater, please have ONE-FEMALE GUARDIAN escort the dancer to the stage door towards the left of the lobby. After signing your dancer in, they will be escorted their waiting area backstage. The dance teams and adult classes will have an assigned classroom, all other classes will wait in the Blackbox area backstage. ONLY ONE FEMALE GUARDIAN PER DANCER WILL BE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE DURING DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCEDURES. PLEASE DO NOT BRING ADDITIONAL FAMILY MEMBERS AND FRIENDS BACKSTAGE DURING DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP. Please be patient with this process. While it may take some time, it is for the safety of our dancers.

Arrival

Dancers should arrive at St. Henry between **6:30** and **6:40** ready to dance in costume, hair fixed, and makeup applied. Upon arrival, ONE female guardian should escort their dancer to the backstage waiting areas by using the stage door located to the left of the lobby area. Once dancers are signed in and dropped off backstage, they are expected to stay in their assigned waiting area for the duration of the show. At no time should students leave to sit with their family/friends in the audience or visit in the lobby area.

Dismissal

After the finale, dancers will be dismissed from the stage. Class by class we will ask ONE female guardian to use the ramp on the left of the stage to meet their dancer. From there, they will proceed to the backstage area to collect their belongings before signing the dancer out. It is our job to keep the children safe and we expect everyone's cooperation with the dismissal process. PLEASE DO NOT BRING ADDITIONAL FAMILY MEMBERS AND FRIENDS BACKSTAGE—IT CAN BECOME CAOTIC AND CROWDED WITH TOO MANY PEOPLE BACKSTAGE AND IN THE DRESSING AREAS. PLEASE HAVE ADDITIONAL "FANS" WAIT IN THE LOBBY TO CONGRATULATE DANCERS ON A JOB WELL DONE.

General Information

- Please make sure your child uses the restroom before they arrive.
- Makeup should be applied at home to avoid dressing room chaos.
- No jewelry should be worn (small stud earrings are okay)
- No nail polish or temporary tattoos.
- Absolutely no food, drinks or smoking is permitted anywhere in the building. Water bottles only.
- No gum.
- Small children should have coloring books, cards, and small games to keep them occupied.
- Please do not send valuables with your dancer.

DANCE EXPRESS

Costumes, Hair, and Make-up

- Costume pieces provided by the studio are listed in the chart below and will be sent home the week of December 5th.
- After the performance, borrowed costume pieces can either be left at the performance (bring a change of clothes for your dancer) or returned to Dance Express the following week.
- Any costume pieces not returned before Christmas break will result in a \$25 costume charge-which will be charged to your card on file on December 20th.
- SHOES—All ballet shoes should be pink and must have the strings tucked in or cut off—NO BOWS.
- MAKEUP—All dancers will need to wear some makeup for the Nutcracker. For younger dancers light mascara, blush and lipstick will do the trick.
- **NO UNDERWEAR UNDER TIGHTS**—Your tights are your underwear! This is specifically important for dancers wearing leotard and tutus.
- HAIR—Girls: Hair should be pulled back into a bun. There are a lot of tutorials on YouTube if you have trouble. HAIRNETS ARE YOUR FRIEND! Younger dancers with short, thin hair can just secure the sides back out of their face. Boys: Comb and style hair neatly.

Recital Package Fee
