			Signals	Gives proper, precise NFHS signals: Strong whistle and voice command. Stops the clock with a fist or palm on whistles. Clear/visible 5-10 second counts. (R,U1,U2)
			Table reporting mechanics	Hustles to foul reporting area, comes to a complete stop to report. Gives clear and precise signals and numbers to the scorer and table personnel. (R,U1,U2)
