

The City of Haviland annually offers this service for the convenience of those in our community and rural areas who own dogs and/or cats. Dogs and cats within the City limits must be licensed each year by April 30. Flea & Tick prevention will be available. Heartworm medication will be available with testing.


***** ANNUAL CITY LICENSE FEES *****

\$4.00 for each neutered or spayed dog or cat.
\$5.00 for each non-neutered or unspayed dog or cat.

The person registering and paying the license fee for a neutered or spayed dog or cat must present a certificate from a licensed veterinarian showing that such dog or cat has been neutered or spayed.

The city office requires a copy of all current rabies vaccine certificates.

City of Haviland Ordinance No. 877 states in part: All dog owners and keepers are required to securely restrain their dog on their premises, to their vehicle or on a leash when not on their premises. Owners and keepers shall not permit dogs to run at large. It shall be unlawful for any person to own or keep any dog or cat over six (6) months of age within the corporate limits of the City of Haviland without registering such dog or cat and paying a yearly license fee for the same. Owners or keepers shall be required to register and pay the license fee for their dog or cat after the dog or cat has reached the age of six months. Upon registration and payment of the license fee, a tag will be issued. The owner or keeper must affix the tag to the registered dog or cat. It shall be unlawful to take off or remove said tag. The tag shall be non-transferable. Dogs and cats must be re-registered each year.

Pet Licenses

Ordinance 377 requires if you live in the city limits to have a license for your cats and dogs. Bring a copy of a current rabies vaccine & proof of altering to City Hall. It only cost \$1.00 for altered or \$3.00 if not altered. Licenses expire April 30th of each year. This is a helpful way for the city to find the owners of lost & found pets.

Keep the Streets & Gutters Clean

When mowing grass, raking leaves, trimming bushes, please don't allow grass clippings, leaves, etc. to end up in the street. These items will find their way into the storm sewer and often cause clogs. Remember to take your branches to the burn pile too! If everyone will do their part in keeping the streets clean it will make our city drains work better during storms.

Sewer Drains

Recently the city sewer lines have been getting plugged up from things going down the drain or being flushed. The city is requesting that you don't flush or let anything go down the drains except for toilet paper. Please don't let mop strings, wipes, feminine products, paper towel, etc go down the drains.

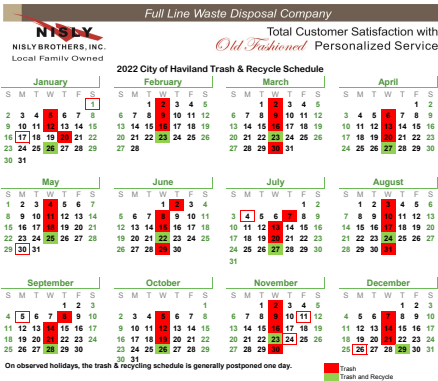


Council Meetings

The city council meets the 2nd Wednesday of the month at 7:00 PM in the Community Room unless otherwise posted. Public welcome! If you have a question, concern or upcoming event that you would like to discuss with the council, please submit a written request by email or in person at City Hall by the 1st of the month so you can be added to the agenda.

Nisly Trash Service

Garbage pick-up is every Wed. unless a major holiday falls the same week then it may be delayed by one day. Recycles are the 4th Wed of the month. Remember to place your recycle cart five feet apart & away from cars so the trucks can get to them. Be sure the lids are facing the street & the lids locked if windy. Please remove them off the street as soon as you can. Be sure to have your carts out by 7:00 a.m. Recycles are picked up later in the day. Stop by City Hall for a recycle schedule.



Debit, Credit & ACH Payments

Do you know that you can pay your utility bills with your debit or credit card? There's a transaction fee of 2.5% for paying with your card. We also offer at no charge, to set up your account with ACH payments too! Are you one who just forgets? ACH payments will help! Taken out on the 2nd business day of the month. Want to pay with your debit/credit card? Leave your card on file at City Hall & we will run it on the 5th working day of the month. Come to City Hall to fill out forms or get them from the Website.
