HELPFUL INFORMATION

BEVERAGES: Absolutely no outside beverages or alcohol are permitted into Honky Tonk Central. Bars are fully stocked for your pleasure. Feel free to imbibe at your own campsites. Thank you for your cooperation.

WI-FI: Wi-Fi available for a fee on your device. Free at Speed Shack. Cell service is spotty so we suggest placing calls with Wi-Fi. Amplified signals are in effect for event but due to number of attendees, it may be slow.

PHONES: Cell phone and device charging stations are located at Law Tigers tent during vendor hours.

MEDICAL: First Aid located at the Info Tent.

VEHICLES: Golf carts and UTV's are permitted with a Pit Pass available at Registration. Absolutely no riding on trails, county road or aggressive driving. No ATV's or 4-wheelers allowed on the Ranch.

PARKING: Free parking lot on the edge of Area 3 for 4-wheeled vehicles and trailers. Premium parking is available for a fee in Honky Tonk Central. Motorcycles park free everywhere.

PETS: Pets welcome. Must be on leash at all times and not permitted in any bar or near food vending. Please clean up pet waste and dispose of properly. You are responsible for any damages your pet may cause to another person or property. No exotic pets per TN law.

SMOKING: Ranch is predominantly non-smoking. No smoking within 50 feet of any building or structure (Pool, Loretta's Roadhouse, BC Moto Builder Barn, etc.)

ICE: Ice is available for purchase at the Speed Shack.

HELMETS: Tennessee is a helmet state.

CAMPING: All overnight camping of any kind must have an event Camping Pass available at Box Office.

SHOWERS: Shower houses located on Stagecoach Hill and Honky Tonk Central. Please respect others and clean up after yourself. Open 24 hours.

FIRE: Group firepits located at Honky Tonk Central and Stagecoach. Individual campfires permitted but required to be in a fire ring; do not leave unattended! Douse at night before sleeping.

TRASH: Please do your part to keep Loretta's property clean. Please bag up and tie up trash. Leave at end of campsite. Pick-ups occur every morning between 7a-8a and afternoons 2-3pm. Do not leave trash out overnight for the critters.

GRILLS: Charcoal grills are available at certain campsites. Please clean out the grills when they have cooled off and close the lid. Do not toss hot coals in the grassy areas.

MASKS: Masks are recommended in close quarters but not required by law. Please bring your own mask and be prepared to wear it when necessary. Please wash your hands often and use hand sanitizer.
