

OneK 2024 RSV VACCINE CLINIC

Times Pharmacy in conjunction with the RCS Dept. will be sponsoring a RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus) clinic. Clinics will be held in the MPR and are by appointment only. You must be 60 years of age or older to receive the vaccination.

- 1/24/24 1p-4p

RCS will begin taking appointments from 10a-2p beginning on 1/2/24 (Mondays – Fridays only). Deadline to make your appointment is 1/17/24. More information will be coming soon in your resident mailboxes.

RSV usually causes mild symptoms however in older adults it can cause severe infection. Similar to COVID, RSV is a highly contagious virus that can be easily spread by touching a contaminated surface, or if an infected person coughs or sneezes and their droplets contact another person's eyes, nose or mouth.


Emergency System Reboot
