RSV Vaccine Clinic Coming in January!

In conjunction with Times Pharmacy, we will be offering an RSV clinic this January, 2024. More information and dates to come in the next few weeks. RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus) is a common, contagious virus. It usually causes mild symptoms however in older adults it can cause severe infection. Similar to COVID, RSV is a highly contagious virus that can be easily spread by touching a contaminated surface, or if an infected person coughs or sneezes and their droplets contact another person's eyes, nose or mouth. You must be 60 years of age or older to receive the vaccination.

THIS WEEK'S SUGGESTION(S): Below are suggestions we have received and our responses:

SUGGESTION: The Administration should look into how residents can be able to get a table to sit in the Dining Room before visitors. Residents at One Kalakaua pay for 1 meal/day even though we do not eat a meal daily.
