Terry, however, never gave up and instead of calling his situation a disability he considers it more as an inconvenience. Throughout his lifetime Terry has made adjustments and always pushed himself to greatness. He successfully became a lawyer with his own practice and became one of the first blind men in the nation to pass the bar exam through brail in 1973. He also became a state representative in 1982 and served for 16 years.

When not practicing law, Terry plays piano on a regular basis and shares his talent and love for music while also spreading his message of hope. "The motto I always lived by was to reach for the stars and dream big. Don't ever give up. Because if I can do it, I know you can."
