

Precautionary measures applying to UN Port

20 May 2020

Welcome to UN Port! We hope you enjoy your stay here. We kindly ask you to take note of the following:

- Please observe two metres of social distancing.
- Staff wear masks for their safety and yours and follow an enhanced disinfection regime.
- Bottles of disinfectant are available at the entrance and other points. Please disinfect your hands on entry.
- The toilets are cleaned at frequent intervals.
- We have grouped chairs and other furniture in the beach area into clusters that are two metres apart from other clusters. Please maintain this and respect the rules on groups of no more than five.
- In the restaurant, tables may be a maximum size of four people who know each other. This can be increased in the case of parents accompanied by their children. Tables are at least two metres from each other.
- Restaurant guests are invited to leave their contact details to enable contact tracing.
- UN Port overall is subject to capacity restrictions to ensure social distancing, which are nevertheless quite generous given the space available. However, once capacity is reached, entry is on a one-in, one-out basis. Please bear with us during these times. During busy periods, members will have priority over those paying entry fees.
- A maximum of five children may use the paddling pool at any time, under adult supervision.
- Classes may consist of a maximum of five people including the coach.
