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There are instructions for each exercise, but the general instructions are to listen first to the audio clip to understand the context before reviewing the questions. Then	MODULE: Listening Comprehension  Instructions for each audio clip:  1. Listen to the audio clip once and ask "What is the context of this audio?" For example, a conversation, a monologue, introduction, narrative statement of an image, announcement or message to someone.  2. Read the questions or statements to be completed, then listen to the audio again.  3. Answer the questions and ask what inferences can be made about unknown words or phrases. Listen again for better understanding.  4. Finally, review the reflection or discussion on the context and lexical association points that you can integrate into your lessons with students.


