


MODULE: Listening Comprehension

- For this module, please become familiar with the following terms and their definitions:
- **Context:** the setting, idea and/or theme of a situation presented by a video, audio clip, dialogue or conversation.
- **Lexical association:** creating a relationship between words from one's native language and in the destination language through similar sound or spelling that give an understanding as to the new word's translation or meaning

<p>There are instructions for each exercise, but the general instructions are to listen first to the audio clip to understand the context before reviewing the questions. Then....</p>	<div data-bbox="1058 597 2018 1128"> <div> <div> MODULE: Listening Comprehension </div>  </div> <p>Instructions for each audio clip:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Listen to the audio clip once and ask <i>“What is the context of this audio?”</i> For example, a conversation, a monologue, introduction, narrative statement of an image, announcement or message to someone. 2. Read the questions or statements to be completed, then listen to the audio again. 3. Answer the questions and ask what inferences can be made about unknown words or phrases. Listen again for better understanding. 4. Finally, review the reflection or discussion on the context and lexical association points that you can integrate into your lessons with students. <div>   </div> </div>



Audio Narration

This is an example of one of the listening exercises. Notice the audio clip with optional transcript (if needed) and the visual image to help with context. See how we can advance through the four or five questions to read them before listening to the audio a second time and then coming back to answer them and move onto the reflection or discussion questions.
