MASTERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

In addition to the RiverPoint Landing Marina-Resort rules and regulations for parking, safety and uses of the property, the following is a general SRC Code of Conduct for all members.

- All rowers and coxswains are on the water to row and learn to better their skill. SRC is deeply committed to providing an inclusive and equitable environment for individuals with diverse cultural backgrounds and regardless of their race, gender, socioeconomic status, or physical ability. All rowers, coaches and coxswains will be treated with respect.
- Be courteous and respectful to RiverPoint Marina's staff, guests and other RiverPoint tenants encountered.
- Members will operate with honesty and integrity. Members should work together toward a common goal.
- Members will avoid swearing or shouting. Do not threaten others nor engage in acts of verbal or physical abuse. Bulling, harassment or hazing is strictly prohibited.
- No member is to critique another rower's performance either on or off the water unless specifically requested by the rower. No one rower should be negatively singled out by another rower.
- All members are expected to learn and follow proper boat handling on land and water and to assist each other with safe handling of all equipment.
- All members are expected to treat SRC equipment with care and are responsible for the careful use of equipment on and off the water. Do not use damaged equipment; all damage to equipment is to be immediately reported.
- All members will help keep the boathouse and surrounding area clean and orderly and take any and all personal gear home.
- All members are expected to assist in boat house workdays and participate with other club activities such as Learn to Row and other events that help the sport of rowing.
- Members are expected to use iCrew and notify their Coach or Captain of any absence in advance of a practice or row.
- Alcohol or any other controlled substance is not to be consumed prior to rowing. During Masters' regattas, alcohol should not be consumed until all races have been completed and equipment is safely loaded
- Any member found to be in violation of these rules may be suspended or removed from the club and forfeit dues, fees or deposits.

RiverPoint Landing Marina-Resort Information

The following requirements apply to all members and other constituents of _____ (hereafter CLUB) while using the facilities known as RiverPoint Landing Marina-Resort (hereafter MARINA).

FACILITY USAGE:

CLUB facilities are available during MARINA's working hours. Summer hours are 9am – 5:30pm. Winter hours are 8:30am – 5pm. Usage outside these hours must be approved in writing by MARINA management.

Uses of common areas, traffic lanes and parking areas may be temporarily marked by approved devices (traffic cones, sawhorses, sandwich boards, etc.). Any equipment related to the activity must be tended and immediately movable at all times. Fire lanes may not be blocked at any time for any reason. MARINA may place further restrictions on such uses at any time without prior notice.

The CLUB and MARINA are parties to an agreement for specific uses of the facility. No uses by CLUB and its members may interfere with the access to and enjoyment of the property by MARINA's other customers, visitors and guests.

VEHICLES/PARKING:

Vehicles may enter MARINA's property to drop off participants for specific activities. Pick up, if required, is also permitted. SPEED LIMIT ON MARINA PROPERTY is 5 mph.

Parking inside the property is not permitted. CLUB or its individual members may make arrangements with the City of Stockton to park in areas outside MARINA's gate.

SECURITY:

Security cameras are in constant use on the property.

The main gate is closed from 5:00 PM to 6:00 AM. An automobile will activate the gate opener by driving within six feet of the gate and coming to a complete stop. Gates adjacent to the launch ramp must be closed and locked when not in use.

RESTROOMS: Facilities are centrally located in the patio area and remain open at all times. Showers are not for use of CLUB members/constituents without special permission from MARINA management.

MARINA is privately owned. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. MARINA is not responsible for any loss or injury due to theft, fire, accident, falling trees, flood, electrical surges, etc. on the premises. Management reserves the right to evict anyone for behavior detrimental to the facility or its guests or for not complying with these requirements and any other MARINA regulations as posted from time to time. Each CLUB member or other constituent must acknowledge these requirements by signature below. A guardian must also sign for users under 18 years of age.
