Submission Guidelines:

- Must be enrolled in May 2025 at I.C.I. Studio School of Art.
- ALL SUBMISSIONS must be photographed and emailed to **admin@ici-studio.com** with the **Art Submission Form** to be considered for exhibition.
- Submission Deadlines:
 - **Email deadline** to submit artwork for consideration: **April 15th**
 - **Accepted Artworks** must be dropped off by or **before May 1** (Final pieces must be framed with title submission slips filled and attached to artwork being dropped off)
- Students will be notified via email of their accepted work(s) within 24 hours to allow enough time for students to get their artwork framed if necessary. Students/parents will be notified in regards to which piece(s) were accepted or declined and additional information will be provided at that time about display options (Whether to frame, wire hook, or alternative method of hanging).

- **2D Submissions:** Students may submit anywhere up to 1 - 5 pieces in this category. 2D drawings and/or paintings will be considered. *Pieces may have been created in or out of the studio. It is required that all drawings are in a frame.

-Canvas panels over 11 X 14 are required to be framed.

-11 X 14 and smaller canvas/canvas panels will be displayed on stands and do not need a frame.

-Canvas at least 1-inch-thick in diameter do not need framed but you are welcome to frame if you want.

- **3D & Digital Art Submissions:** Students may submit up to 1 - 5 pieces in this category. 3D, sculpture, and digital art will be considered. *Pieces may have been created in or out of the studio.

-If any digital work is accepted, it will be your responsibility to have the work printed and framed or gallery-ready (hangable). We are happy to refer you to the right company for printing.

**Please make sure all frames have a proper saw tooth hook or wire on the back for the curatorial staff to easily hang them. If you need any assistance with this or guidance on finding affordable framing, please let us know.
