Friday: July 2 to Monday: July 5	4 <sup>th</sup> of July Weekend
Friday: August 13 to Sunday: August 15	
Friday: Sept. 3 to Monday: Sept. 6	Labor Day Weekend

We ask the following:

- Please avoid going to public places and large groups with resident.
- Please continue to wear face masks and observe social distancing.
- Please follow dates of visiting schedule, this helps with staffing census and planning activities.

Visits at Mount St. Joseph is possible only outdoors. We ask that you inform your QIDP or Michelle (Social Services) or the Housemother/House Manager of the Cottage of your desire to visit. Visitations require that masks be worn by visitors at all times. Visits can be made in the gazebo, walking around Mount St. Joseph, sitting in your car. If you want to bring food or drink, this can be brought for the resident to enjoy.

Essential visits to private doctors can be made now. Please contact Nursing regarding any appointments with their Doctors and for the paperwork.
