GABRIEL BACKED BY PROMINENT ENVIRONMENTAL GROUP IN AD-45 BID

Jesse Gabriel Earns Support of California League of Conservation Voters in State Assembly Campaign

ENCINO, CA -- Serving as further evidence of his growing momentum, today Constitutional Rights Attorney Jesse Gabriel was endorsed by the California League of Conservation Voters.

In announcing their support, Mike Young, CLCV Associate Director of Campaigns and Organizing, released the following statement:

"Jesse Gabriel understands the environmental challenges facing the San Fernando Valley and has a long track record of working to protect our environment. Jesse will be a strong advocate for the environment in Sacramento and will fight hard to make sure that Valley residents have clean air, clean water, more open space, and better public transportation."

Just last week, Congressmembers Brad Sherman, Karen Bass, and Napolitano backed Gabriel's bid. Gabriel has also been endorsed by the Democratic Party of the San Fernando Valley (DPSFV), the Steamfitters - Refrigeration Fitters of United Association (UA) Local 250, the Los Angeles County Young Democrats, Service Employees International Union (SEIU) California State Council, the International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees, Teamsters Joint Council 42 and a far-reaching coalition of neighborhood leaders, small business owners, Democratic activists, and Jewish community leaders.

Gabriel's decisive winning streak is the latest in a series of positive developments for his campaign. Just days ago, Gabriel announced that he has raised over \$500,000 for his primary bid – placing him nearly \$400,000 ahead of his nearest competitor.

Today's news comes a week after Gabriel rolled out a new digital video ad, "*Twice*."

Gabriel has been dominating the race for State Assembly District 45 by every measurement, from fundraising to endorsements to grassroots support. Just last week he picked up endorsements from the California Legislative Jewish Caucus, Democrats to Israel - Los Angeles, State Senator Scott Weiner and State Assemblymember Marc Berman.

Jesse Gabriel is a Los Angeles County Commissioner and Constitutional Rights Attorney who has represented clients before the United States Supreme Court. He is currently suing the Trump Administration in two landmark lawsuits which seek to protect undocumented children known as Dreamers. Through his legal work and legislative advocacy, Jesse has assisted Holocaust survivors, victims of domestic abuse, and communities facing the threat of hate-motivated violence. Jesse has also helped to resolve complex business disputes through his work with a major law firm. Prior to beginning his law practice, Jesse worked to advance the Democratic Party agenda in the United States Senate, where he served as a senior advisor to former United States Senator Evan Bayh. A committed environmentalist and longtime community activist, Jesse also serves on the board of directors of the Los Angeles League of Conservation Voters and the Jewish Federation of Greater Los Angeles, and as a Commissioner on the Los Angeles County Commission on Local Government Services.

Jesse lives in Encino with his wife Rachel Rosner, an affordable housing attorney, and their sons Ethan and Joshua. He is a graduate of Harvard Law School and UC Berkeley.
