JESSE GABRIEL EXPANDS SUPPORT FROM WORKING FAMILIES IN ASSEMBLY BID

Gabriel Lands Another Key Endorsement the Day After Winning Backing from the Democratic Party of the San Fernando Valley

ENCINO, CA -- On the heels of winning a coveted endorsement from the Democratic Party of the San Fernando Valley (DPSFV), today Constitutional Rights Attorney Jesse Gabriel picked up the support of the Steamfitters - Refrigeration Fitters of United Association (UA) Local 250 in his campaign for State Assembly District 45.

Gabriel has also been endorsed by the Los Angeles County Young Democrats, Service Employees International Union (SEIU) California State Council, the International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees, Teamsters Joint Council 42 and a far-reaching coalition of neighborhood leaders, small business owners, Democratic activists, and Jewish community leaders.

In making public their endorsement, the Steamfitters - Refrigeration Fitters of United Association (UA) Local 250, released the following statement:

"The Steamfitters - Refrigeration Fitters of United Association (UA) Local 250 are proud to endorse Jesse Gabriel for State Assembly. We know that Jesse Gabriel will fight tirelessly on behalf of working families to build a strong middle class economy. From prioritizing job-training and apprenticeship programs to investing more in infrastructure to improve our local communities' quality of life, Jesse Gabriel is a leader we can count on to get things done in Sacramento."

Gabriel's decisive winning streak is the latest in a series of positive developments for his campaign. Just days ago, Gabriel announced that he has raised over \$500,000 for his primary bid – placing him nearly \$400,000 ahead of his nearest competitor.

Gabriel has been dominating the race for State Assembly District 45 by every measurement, from fundraising to endorsements to grassroots support. Just last week he picked up endorsements from the California Legislative Jewish Caucus, Democrats to Israel - Los Angeles, State Senator Scott Weiner and State Assemblymember Marc Berman.

Jesse Gabriel is a Los Angeles County Commissioner and Constitutional Rights Attorney who has represented clients before the United States Supreme Court. He is currently suing the Trump Administration in two landmark lawsuits which seek to protect undocumented children known as Dreamers. Through his legal work and legislative advocacy, Jesse has assisted Holocaust survivors, victims of domestic abuse, and communities facing the threat of hate-motivated violence. Jesse has also helped to resolve complex business disputes through his work with a major law firm. Prior to beginning his law practice, Jesse worked to advance the Democratic Party agenda in the United States Senate, where he served as a senior advisor to former United States Senator Evan Bayh.

A committed environmentalist and longtime community activist, Jesse also serves on the board of directors of the Los Angeles League of Conservation Voters and the Jewish Federation of Greater Los Angeles, and as a Commissioner on the Los Angeles County Commission on Local Government Services.

Jesse lives in Encino with his wife Rachel Rosner, an affordable housing attorney, and their sons Ethan and Joshua. He is a graduate of Harvard Law School and UC Berkeley.
