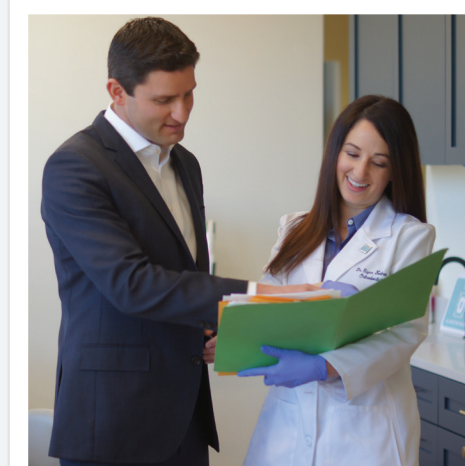
### Make Higher Education More Affordable
