The Committee may accept up to \$5,900 per election from individuals, businesses, labor organizations and PACs, and up to \$11,800 from registered small contributor committees. Couples may contribute \$11,800 which will be attributed \$5,900 to each person. Both individuals must sign the check and remit form and provide the required information for campaign finance reporting. Contributions must be made from the donors' own funds and may not be reimbursed by any other person. Contributions from foreign nationals who lack permanent residence in the United States are prohibited.
