Frank D. Mattingly Scholarship Application

This is a scholarship offered by The Fraternal Order of Police, Town Branch Lodge 83 ("Lodge 83"), which represents the men and women of the Lexington, KY, Department of Community Corrections. This scholarship is awarded for recognition of community service and civic contributions made by the applicant for the betterment of the community. Eligibility is limited to residents of Fayette County, and to sworn law enforcement officers ("LEOs") employed by LFUCG, or their immediate family members. The Frank D. Mattingly Scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable award in the amount of \$1,000. No additional or recurring payments will be made.

Eligibility

- Applicants must either reside in Lexington, Kentucky, or be an immediate family member (spouse, child, or legal dependent) of a sworn LEO employed by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government.
- Applicants must demonstrate a meaningful commitment to community service or civic engagement.
- Only fully completed applications submitted by the stated deadline will be considered. Incomplete or late submissions will not be reviewed.
