Existing Carbon Reduction Initiatives

At Great Minds, together, we are always taking proactive steps to reduce our carbon footprint through remote working and recycling initiatives.

Waste Reduction & Recycling

Localised paper shredding facilities as a sustainability initiative. - Great Minds Together receives a certificate of destruction from Shred on Site in accordance with the provisions set out in Information Destruction BS EN 15713 and has two consoles at their Head Office in Stockport, which are emptied, shredded, and recycled every four weeks.

E-Waste Recycling - Responsible disposal of outdated IT equipment and electronics.

Recycling Program – Providing clear waste separation bins for paper, plastics, e-waste, and general waste.

Energy Efficiency

We have replaced traditional bulbs with LED lighting. Replacing traditional bulbs with LEDs to reduce unnecessary energy consumption.

Sustainable Commuting & Travel

Remote & Hybrid Working Policies—Our current employee contracts allow flexible work-from-home arrangements, reducing commuting-related emissions.

Water Conservation

Leak Detection & Maintenance - We regularly check for leaks to prevent water wastage.



Eco-Friendly Office Supplies

We source recycled paper, non-toxic cleaning products, and sustainable furniture.

Paperless Office Initiatives

We encourage digital documents over printing, using e-signatures, and cloud storage.

Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives

To reduce our carbon footprint, we are implementing the following measures:

Short-Term Actions (1-3 Years)

- Energy Efficiency: Optimising heating/cooling systems. Use ENERGY STAR-rated computers, printers, and kitchen appliances.
- Green Energy Procurement: Transitioning to renewable electricity suppliers.
- Sustainable Travel Policies: Encouraging public transport, EVs, and remote working.
- Green Energy Procurement Switching to renewable energy sources like solar panels or green energy tariffs.
- Encouraging Power Down Policies Ensuring computers, monitors, and non-essential equipment are switched off when not in use.
- Cycle-to-Work & Public Transport Incentives Encouraging employees to use sustainable transport options.
- Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Points Installing EV chargers to support staff using electric cars.
- Reducing Business Travel Prioritising virtual meetings over long commutes.
- Water-saving fixtures Installing low-flow taps, dual-flush toilets, and water-efficient appliances.
- Carbon Offsetting Programs Partnering with tree-planting or carbon offset initiatives.
- Employee Engagement & Green Champions Creating a sustainability committee to promote and implement green policies.



Medium-Term Actions (3-7 Years)

Phasing out fossil-fuel vehicles in favour of EVs.
Sustainable Supply Chain: Working with suppliers to cut emissions.
Reducing waste, increasing recycling, and minimizing packaging.

Long-Term Actions (7+ Years)

Carbon Offsetting: Investing in verified carbon removal projects e.g. planting trees to absorb CO2. Go paperless and conserve heat and energy and waste management.
