Meet Your Hosts José Rizo & David Benoit!



José Rizo was born in Guadalajara, Mexico and raised in Oxnard, California. He played trumpet in high school, but it was not until he was a student at U.C. Santa Barbara that he developed his passion for jazz. In the late 70s, José was the founder of "Radio Chicano", a student and community broadcasting organization based on the Santa Barbara campus at KCSB, where he served as program director for two years. Rizo began hosting "Jazz on the Latin Side" on KLON (now KJazz) in early 1990. He was intricately involved on KLON's "Latin Jazz Club Caravans" and served as a member of the Grammy's Screening committee for Latin Jazz. He has been the artistic director of the Luckman Fine Arts Latin Jazz Concert Series and involved in the "Central Avenue Jazz Festival" since its inception.



Over the last quarter century, composer and pianist **David Benoit** has been a passionate musical innovator committed to the exploration of many different art forms on the American landscape. A five-time GRAMMY nominee for his seminal contributions to the genre of contemporary jazz, Benoit has also embarked on a multi-faceted journey into the classical music world. This has led to guest pianist and conductor spots with numerous top orchestras, four performances at Carnegie Hall (including one with Leonard Bernstein at the podium), a performance on the steps of the Capitol Building with the National Symphony for the annual PBS July 4th event, and the creation of his new orchestral work, Dolores Del Carmen, and chamber composition, Music for Two Trios.



Alexander Beets: Described as "one of the rare tenor heroes of his time," Alexander's nickname "The Hurricane" comes from his explosive and expressive playing. As a jazz saxophone player, he has given over 2000 concerts around the world. Alexander has been the director of the Amersfoort Jazz Festival for 21 years. This festival has eight stages spread across the old city of Amersfoort, mainly on the historic squares. It is a large free three-day event, and it attracts over 100,000 visitors every year. We are thrilled that Alexander is available for the journey and he looks forward to playing in the intimate setting of our floating jazz festival.



Matthew Brumley, Founder, Earthbound Expeditions: Matthew has been leading and creating specialized, educational adventures for public radio stations worldwide for 25 years. After attending universities in the USA, Copenhagen and Moscow, Russia, he went on to attend the graduate program at the London School of Economics. Matthew was the senior guide on the Orient Express & Trans-Siberian Rail. He has worked in Europe, Africa, South America, Asia, New Zealand and North America and has lived in Copenhagen, Paris, London, Tel Aviv and San Jose, Costa Rica. Matthew lives with his wife and fellow Earthbound founder, Danna Brumley on Bainbridge Island, WA.

Day 0: Depart the USA for Amsterdam!

Our jazz music journey through Holland, Germany, France and Switzerland begins in the historic heart of Amsterdam as we board the elegant, MS Symphonie. This evening, enjoy a welcome aboard dinner with your ship captain, KJAZZ hosts, guides and fellow travelers. Sleep on board (D)

Day 2: May 23 - Amsterdam

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast on board the ship. Embark on an enchanting canal cruise through Amsterdam, where history, art, and culture converge. Glide along UNESCO-listed canals, marveling at narrow houses, grand mansions, and charming bridges. Amsterdam promises a sensory feast, blending ancient allure with modern vibrancy. Prepare to be captivated at every corner!

We'll return on board and have dinner, followed by an evening jazz concert. Our ship will cruise to Nijmegen overnight. *Sleep on board (B, L, D)*

Or join an outing to explore an infamous World War II battle: the Battle of Arnhem, which took place from September 17-26, 1944 and was the last episode of Operation Market Garden. This bold attempt to achieve a swift breakthrough to heartland Germany beyond the Rhine, came to a halt in Arnhem.

As the day winds down, our ship will set sail for Cologne under the

stars. Enjoy a jazz concert this evening. Sleep on board (B, L, D)

Day 4: May 25 - Cologne - Koblenz

Today enjoy a guided tour of Cologne, a city steeped in history as the crossroads of Europe since the Middle Ages. Prepare to be awestruck by the towering Gothic cathedral, an architectural masterpiece that stands as the tallest twin-spired church globally and Germany's most visited landmark. After marveling at this iconic structure, we'll wander through the charming streets of the Old Town, where history whispers from every cobblestone. Return to the ship for a delicious dinner. Enjoy a jazz concert this evening. *Sleep on board (B, L, D)*

Day 9: May 30 - Discover the Magic of Lucerne

After breakfast, explore Lucerne's heritage with a walking tour. Wander cobblestone paths to see architectural marvels, including the historic Chapel Bridge and the Lion of Lucerne monument, honoring Swiss Guards from the French Revolution.

The afternoon is free to explore at your leisure. Art enthusiasts may wish to visit the Rosengart Museum to see works by Paul Klee and Pablo Picasso or the Wagner Museum, set in the composer's former home by Lake Lucerne and the Alps. *Sleep in Lucerne (B)*

Enjoy a leisurely morning in Lucerne, taking in the peaceful atmosphere at your own pace. In the afternoon, join us for a delightful farewell fondue lunch, a cherished Swiss tradition. 








MS SYMPHONIE DECK PLAN & PRICING

Reservations and Deposits: A \$750 per person deposit is required to confirm your space on this journey. Deposits can be made via credit card or by calling the Earthbound office at 206.842.9775. A deposit packet will be emailed confirming the receipt of your deposit. All cancellations must be made in writing and are effective upon receipt in our office. A \$250 per person fee applies to all cancellations. Deposits are refundable, minus the cancellation fee, for 30 days from the processing date or 90 days prior to departure, whichever comes first. A progress payment will be due approximately five months before departure, followed by a final payment due 90 days before departure, both of which are non-refundable. In addition, all payments made within 90 days prior to the trip's departure date are non-refundable, which is why we strongly urge guests to purchase travel insurance.

Not Included: International airline tickets, premium alcoholic beverages on board the ship, room service and gratuities for ship crew and staff, hotel staff, travel insurance, meals not listed in brochure, and any activities or items not listed in your itinerary.
