Walk in the footsteps of the great explorers while in Portugal

DAY 2 Thursday, May 6th: Discover Vibrant Lisbon

After breakfast, we set out to explore Lisbon, beginning in the Belém district with an in-depth visit to the magnificent Jerónimos Monastery. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, this masterpiece is one of the finest examples of Portugal's late Gothic Manueline architectural style. Nearby, we'll also view the iconic Tower of Belém, a monument honoring Portugal's great Age of Exploration.

We then continue with a walking tour through the narrow, winding streets of the Alfama District, where you'll gain insight into Lisbon's rich, layered, and multicultural history. *Sleep in Lisbon (B, L)*

DAY 3 Friday, May 7th: Excursion to Sintra and Fado

Today we embark on a short journey to a village of fantasy castles nestled in lush green valleys and surrounded by exotic tropical plants. Portugal's kings and other wealthy aristocrats of the kingdom came to Sintra to build magnificent summer homes and stunning gardens to while away their time gazing at the shimmering Atlantic in the distance. Today Sintra is busy and bustling with visitors but remains a highlight worth the visit. Dinner together this evening will include a Portuguese traditional form of singing called *Fado*. *Sleep in Lisbon (B, D)*

Dining in Iberia: We have intentionally included all breakfasts, along with one additional multi-course meal each day. In keeping with local tradition in Iberia, this is typically a substantial, multi-course lunch. It's also worth noting that most restaurants do not open for dinner until 8:00 or 9:00 p.m., so we recommend enjoying the many delicious variations of tapas in the evening.

Explore the culture and history of Spain

DAY 4 Saturday, May 8th: Évora and on to Seville

After breakfast, we journey to the whitewashed city of Évora, home to the Roman Temple of Diana, the Gothic Igreja de São Francisco, and its striking Chapel of Bones. Set amid rolling cork and olive groves, Évora is also an ideal place to visit a traditional cork farm. After lunch, we continue on to Seville, the vibrant capital of Andalusia. Steeped in Roman, Moorish, and Golden Age history—and home to three UNESCO World Heritage Sites within its old town—Seville will be our base for the next three nights. This evening, enjoy a group tapas dinner. *Sleep in Seville (B, L, D)*

DAY 5 Sunday, May 9th: Seville & Barrio Santa Cruz

Discover the soul of Seville on a guided walking tour through the enchanting Barrio Santa Cruz, the city's historic Jewish quarter. Wander its winding cobblestone lanes, hidden courtyards, and flower-filled plazas before arriving at the magnificent Seville Cathedral—the largest Gothic cathedral in the world—home to the tomb of Christopher Columbus and crowned by its iconic, climbable bell tower.

Enjoy an included multi-course group lunch, followed by a leisurely afternoon to explore at your own pace. *Sleep in Seville (B, L)*

Spend a day exploring the Alhambra of Granada

DAY 6 Monday, May 10th: The Royal Alcázar

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Royal Alcázar of Seville is Europe's oldest royal palace still in use. Originally built as an 11th-century Moorish fortress, it has evolved into a stunning complex of palaces and gardens showcasing centuries of architectural styles. After our guided visit, enjoy a multi-course lunch. The afternoon is yours to explore Seville's museums, shops, and charming cobbled streets at your own pace. This evening, delight in an included, colorful Flamenco performance.

DAY 7 Tuesday, May 11th: Drive to Granada via Cordoba

Today's drive takes us to Granada, with a stop along the way in Córdoba. Once a regional capital under both Roman and Moorish rule, Córdoba is home to one of the finest Islamic monuments in Europe—second only to Granada's Alhambra. The Mezquita is an exceptionally well-preserved 8th-century mosque and a true architectural masterpiece. After a short walking tour and guided visit to the Mezquita, you'll have free time to explore the lively maze of streets and enjoy an independent lunch at one of the many local restaurants.

We then continue to Granada. Time permitting, we'll visit the Royal Chapel upon arrival to see the tombs of Queen Isabella and King Ferdinand before checking into our hotel. This evening, we'll head out again to enjoy dinner. *Sleep in Granada (B, D)*

DAY 8 Wednesday, May 12th: Explore Granada

The highlight of Granada is the spectacular Alhambra palace and its surrounding gardens and splashing fountains. It's very easy to imagine yourself here, reclining on a fluffy divan with a servant feeding you grapes... We'll tour the complex with a local expert and leave time for a well-earned siesta this afternoon.

Dinner is in the Albaizin (old Moorish quarter). Be sure to find a viewpoint to see the Alhambra lit up at night. Sigh... *Sleep in Granada (B, D)*

DAY 9 Thursday, May 13th: Granada to Madrid: In search of Don Quixote and Wines of Spain

After breakfast, our coach travels north through rolling landscapes of endless olive groves en route to Madrid. Along the way, we stop to visit the iconic windmills of La Mancha—the very windmills that inspired *Don Quixote*, Spain's most influential literary work. Several of these historic mills are still in operation and open to visitors. Later in the afternoon, enjoy a feast paired with a wine tasting at a charming local winery. We arrive in Madrid in the early evening. *Sleep in Madrid (B, D)*

DAY 10 Friday, May 14th: Great Museums of Madrid – The Prado

This morning we explore Madrid's artistic heart with a visit to the world-renowned Museo del Prado. Home to the finest collection of Spanish art, the museum highlights masterpieces of the Golden Age, including celebrated works by Velázquez, Goya, and El Greco. After, we will enjoy a multi-course farewell lunch together in central Madrid. The afternoon is free to explore on your own—perhaps the Reina Sofía, the Royal Palace, or the lively Plaza Mayor. Madrid's rich culture and history provide a memorable finale to our journey. *Sleep in Madrid (B, L)*

DAY 11 Saturday, May 15th: Return Home with a Lifetime of Memories!

Your WABE journey concludes after breakfast; however, you may wish to extend your stay and continue exploring Spain. Consider spending additional time in Madrid, perhaps visiting the renowned Reina Sofia Museum which boasts works by Picasso and Dali.
