

# Join WSHU IRELAND

## Kilkenny & Rock of Cashel Days 3-4 Sept. 23 - 25

Explore the historic charm of Kilkenny, one of Ireland's most beautiful towns along the River Nore. Discover its medieval heart on a guided walking tour, featuring cobbled streets, colorful shops, and the iconic 12th-century Kilkenny Castle, a former Butler family stronghold. In the evening, enjoy a delicious dinner and soak in the town's welcoming atmosphere.



Venture to County Tipperary for a visit to the iconic Rock of Cashel, a site steeped in history and legend. Once the seat of the kings of Munster, the hilltop fortress features Cormac's Chapel with its rare Romanesque frescoes and breathtaking views of the Irish countryside. With its perfect blend of history, culture, and scenic beauty, Kilkenny offers an unforgettable experience.



enchanting destination via the riverside town of Waterford, famous for its world-class crystal, and explore the 17th-century Charles' Fort near Cork. Once in Killarney, settle into this idyllic setting known as "Heaven's Reflex," where mountains, woodlands, and lakes combine to create Ireland's most picturesque valley.

Explore the Dingle Peninsula, home to ancient sites, charming villages, and spectacular views. Highlights include the Gallarus Oratory, Beehive Huts, and the Blasket Center, celebrating Irish heritage. Visit Killarney National Park, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, with its majestic mountains, serene lakes, and the historic Muckross House and Gardens. Killarney is a perfect blend of natural beauty and cultural richness, offering unforgettable Irish experience.

# Galway Days 8 - 9 Sept. 28 - 29

Travel from Killarney to Galway, stopping at the 13th-century Bunratty Castle in County Limerick and perhaps enjoying a pint at historic Durty Nelly's pub. Journey through the lush countryside to Thoor Ballylee, the 14th-century Norman tower where W.B. Yeats wrote some of his greatest works. Arrive in Galway, check into your centrally located hotel, and enjoy drinks and dinner with friends. Explore the breathtaking Cliffs of Moher, with an optional boat cruise offering stunning views from the Atlantic, and the unique limestone landscape of the Burren, filled with ancient tombs and stone formations. Visit the charming village of Doolin and the high crosses of Kilnefora before returning to Galway. Depart from Shannon Airport with cherished memories of Ireland.

A \$1000 per person deposit is needed to confirm your space on this journey. You can make a credit card deposit online or by phone. Deposits are refundable, minus a \$250 per person cancellation fee, for 60 days from the processing date or until 90 days prior to departure, whichever comes first. Deposits made 90 days prior to a trip departing are not refundable. Final payment is also non-refundable, which is why we strongly urge guests to purchase travel insurance.
